Criteria: Applicant must:

3. Possess qualities of leadership, character and a genuine concern for others
4. Have a solid scholastic record: B/3.0 average and/or rank in upper 25% of class
5. Include your official high school transcript and up to two letters of recommendation from someone other than a family member with completed application.
6. Apply at www.dhlscholar.org/Application by March 31, 2024 or mail applications postmarked no later than March 31st to: Dallas Hirst Lumpkin Scholarship, 1211 Adger Road, Columbia, SC 29205.

Award:

- The scholarship will be announced at the end of the school year at the high school awards program. The winner will receive a check made co-payable to their chosen educational institution and the recipient prior to the fall semester.
- Any member of the Dallas Hirst Lumpkin family is ineligible for this award.
